Peter Chow is an international arbitrator. He has substantial experience with high-stakes, complex international disputes globally, including those related to energy & natural resources, oil & gas, infrastructure & construction and technology projects, shareholders, private equity investments and other commercial disputes.

Prior to practising as an independent arbitrator in 2023, Peter was a partner at King & Spalding (Singapore) and Squire Patton Boggs (Hong Kong). He has held various leadership roles, including head of Asia disputes practice, global head of Greater China practice and head of office, as a partner at various US international law firms. He has practised in Singapore, Hong Kong and Australia.

Peter has represented clients in some of the largest arbitrations in Asia, including 5 cases involving multi-billion US dollar claims. He has been involved in arbitrations in Asia for over 30 years and has acted as counsel in numerous arbitration cases, including those involving ICC, HKIAC, SIAC, CIETAC, ICDR, AAA, NAI and UNCITRAL arbitral rules.

Peter is also a Chartered Arbitrator and on the panels of arbitrators of the major arbitration institutions in a number of countries.
